



**Q** What is the one thing that most brides fail to consider when planning a wedding?

**A** When doing a seated dinner, a bride really needs to take into consideration what will be served for dinner, (giving the guests a choice or serving everyone the same thing and having a duel entrée), planning the seating chart and the use of escort and place cards. For an outdoor wedding, the thing that is always forgotten is power and how that is going to be handled for lighting, food, band, etc.

**Q** Local, destination or private—what should brides consider before making a decision as to which kind of wedding they want to have?

**Q** Outside of a groom's cake, what are some other suggestions for expressing the groom's style at the wedding or reception?

**A** I had a bride and groom recently who did a lot of charity work, so the guests hung their place cards on a philanthropic board that the bride and groom made.
